

Beatles & Boxing

A monochrome photograph of The Beatles and Cassius Clay is included in the Charterhouse specialist auction of Rock, Pop, Film and Entertainment Memorabilia on **Wednesday 26th February**.

“Icons of the mid to late 20th century the photo has great appeal to music and boxing fans and is estimated at £300-£500,” commented John Snape.

The Beatles meet Cassius Clay in February 1964 on a trip to America just before Clay was crowned World Heavyweight Boxing Champion and changed his name to Muhammad Ali.

The photograph, signed by Cassius Clay, was collected by the owner’s late uncle who worked as a music promoter in America during the 1960’s.
