

# Dorset History Mapped Out

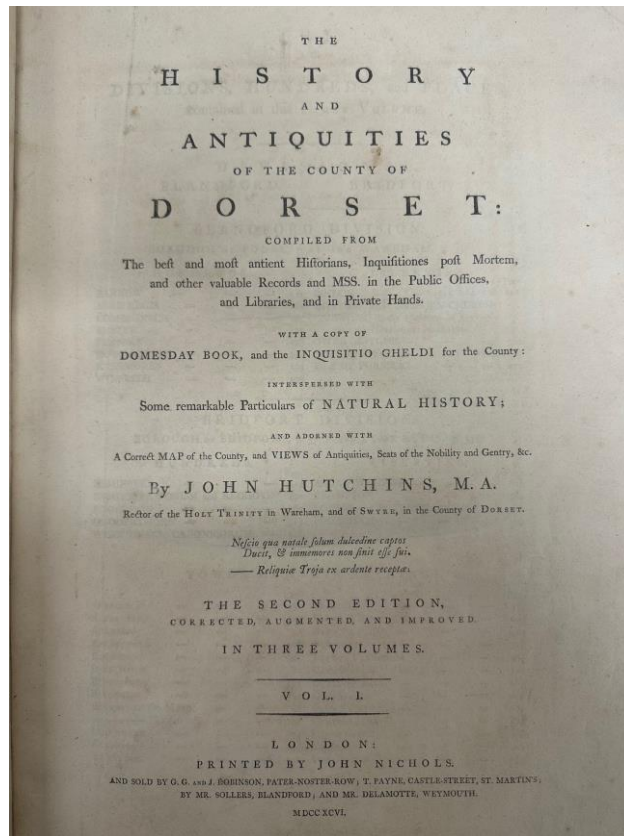
A single owner collection of Dorset related books and maps are included the Charterhouse auction of pictures and books on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> January.**
