

Motorcycles at Charterhouse

There are nearly 140 pioneer, veteran, vintage, classic and modern motorcycles in the Charterhouse auction being held at the **Haynes Motor Museum** on **Thursday 13th March**.

The earliest motorcycle dates to 1900 with the newest having rolled off the Kawasaki production line in 2019. There is a vast range of bikes from 50cc mopeds to an 1,890cc Indian trike.
