

Rare Royal Doulton Pattern Book Comes to Charterhouse

A rare Royal Doulton pattern book, dating to the 1920's, is being sold by Charterhouse in Sherborne on **Friday 31st January**.

"There is an amazing selection of original drawings and designs complete with annotations regarding colours and noting artists at the height of the Art Deco era," commented Richard Bromell.

The book illustrates a vast number of designs, and in particular from the Royal Doulton Titanian range. Still with fresh and vibrant colours as they have been kept out of the sun, some pages are however, a little grubby, no doubt from having been referred to and thumbed over the years.
